DEFINITION OF MEMBERSHIP

HOUSEHOLD – A household is defined as up to two adults and dependent children through 22 years of age (and a full-time college student) living in the household.

1 ADULT HOUSEHOLD – A household is defined as one adult and dependent children through 22 years of age (and a full-time college student) living in the household.

SENIOR – Any person 62 years of age or above

ADULT – Any person 25–61 years of age.

YOUNG ADULT – Any person 19-25 years of age

COLLEGE – Full time student with a minimum of 12 credits

YOUTH – Any person 18 years of age or younger.

MEMBERSHIP AGREEMENT

1. For cancellations or changes, we require a written cancellation notice or change notice sixty days in advance. Members are responsible for reviewing bank statements to verify their draft cancellation and notifying us within 30 days if draft has failed to terminate. No refunds will be given beyond 60 days.
2. Should any draft not be honored for any reason by your bank, the member is responsible for the payment plus a service charge of \$30.00.

Monthly payment is through Electronic Funds Transfer (EFT) or Credit Card debit. Automatic withdrawals are made from checking or savings accounts on the 15th day of each month. Joining fees are non-refundable, they are a one-time charge if membership remains continuous. The joining fee will be required if membership has lapsed for more than 30 days. Membership is not transferable to other individuals and may be revoked for inappropriate behavior or by not abiding by the rules, regulations, and policies of the Y.

FACILITY AGE REQUIREMENT

Children age 7 and under are not permitted into the facility without the direct supervision of a person age 14 or older unless enrolled in a program. Children age 8 and above may use the facility unsupervised, if they do so in a responsible manner.

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

The Y is a cause-driven organization “for all.” Our financial assistance program ensures that anyone can participate in Y programs, despite the inability to pay the full program fee. At the Y, no child, family or adult is turned away due to lack of financial ability.
