Position Title: Child Watch Staff

Job Summary:

The person(s) selected for the position will be responsible for creating a safe, positive, enriched and fun child watch service for members and participants

Qualifications:

Must be 15 years or older. Must have a warm and friendly personality and be sensitive and mature individual who is able to relate to both children and adults. Child watch staff must follow appropriate dress code and demonstrate the core values of the YMCA's Character Development: Caring, Honesty, Respect and Responsibility.

Essential Functions:

Responsibilities include but not limited to the following:

- Take the job seriously and with the thought in mind that the safety of children depends upon the attentiveness to your work.
- Implement general cleaning tasks and practice good hygiene.
- Enforce safety rules.
- Engage and interact with kids in activities to keep them content and happy while in the room. Make it a positive experience for the child.
- Mandatory presence throughout the child watch room.
- Be knowledgeable of and implement emergency procedures.
- Enforce rules and guidelines.

- Establish and maintain relationships with parents/quardians
- Develop and maintain positive relationships with other YMCA personnel

- Lift up to 50 pounds.
